## Objective

Outline the policy regarding accident reporting on University of Michigan (U-M) vehicles.

## Insurance Coverage Policy

- 1. All vehicles owned by U-M will be identified by a vehicle number, U-M decal and special municipal license plate issued by Fleet Services.
- 2. All vehicles owned by U-M are covered by the U-M self insurance program administered by Risk Management.

## Policy

- 1. An accident is defined as any incident that causes damage to persons or property.
- 2. In the glove box of every U-M vehicle is a Driver's report of vehicle damage or public incident form (vehicle damage report). This form is also available on our website at pts.umich.edu under forms as Drivers Report of Vehicle Damage.
- 3. Vehicle damage report needs to be completed in its entirety and submitted to Fleet Services within 48 hours of the accident.
- 4. Garage Services will process the vehicle damage report and make arrangements for the repair of the U-M vehicle.
- 5. Failure to report damage to U-M vehicles or submit a vehicle damage report will result in billing the entire cost of the repair to the using department.
