Medical Certification Procedure

Objective

Outline the procedure for operating vehicles at University of Michigan (U-M) that require medical certification according to State of Michigan law.

Medical Certification Policy

- 1. If the gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of the vehicle you are operating is greater than 10,000 pounds, you are required to have a current valid DOT medical card.
- 2. Or if you are towing a vehicle with the GVWR of 10,000 pounds or more, you are required to have a current valid DOT medical card.

Medical Certification Procedure

- 1. Determine if the vehicle you are operating requires a DOT medical card.
- 2. If you are unsure if the vehicle requires a DOT medical card, contact Fleet Services at (734) 764-3427. Fleet Services staff will be able to assist you please have the U-M vehicle number when calling.
- DOT medical card may be obtained through U-M Employee Health Services. You
 need to contact them to schedule an appointment for a medical certification
 physical.
- 4. U-M Employee Health Services will provide the U-M operator with a DOT medical card once you have passed the physical. The DOT medical card is valid for two (2) years.
- 5. You are required to carry the DOT medical card whenever you are operating the U-M vehicle that requires it. You should treat this as an extension of your driver's license when operating vehicles.
