MEDICAL CAMPUS SPECIAL PARKING PROGRAMS

Work shifts at the Medical Campus are varied and diverse to accommodate the hospitals 24 hours/7 days a week operation. The following information has been prepared to assist you in considering parking options to meet your needs.

EARLY & LATE EVENING PARKING OPTIONS

Yellow AVI Permit – Yellow AVI permits are honored at the P3 (Taubman) and M93 (Wall Street) Parking Structures during the restricted hours below.

M93 (Wall Street Parking Structure) Monday through Thursday

Entry: 5:15 pm – 4 am Exit: 5:15 pm – 9 am P3 (Taubman Parking Structure) Monday through Thursday

Entry: 6 pm - 4 amExit: 6 pm - 8:30 am

Weekends

Entry or Exit: 5:15 pm Friday to 9 am Monday

Blue AVI Permit – P1 (Cancer Center) and P4 (Mott/Simpson) structures are enforced 24 hours/7 days. These structures start to empty at approximately 4 pm. Blue parkers will find available parking spaces throughout the evening hours.

Upon request to umpark@umich.edu, Blue parkers can obtain restricted evening/weekend access to the P3 (Taubman Parking Structure) or P5 (Cardiovascular Parking Structure). Monday through Friday entrances may occur between 4:30 pm and 5 am; exits must occur no later than 9 am at P3 and 8 am at P5. 24-hour access is allowed on the weekends. Note: At P5, the prevailing hourly parking rate will be charged for exits after the stated exit time, unless your supervisor has made arrangements with Parking Customer Services to exit after 8 am.

No Parking Permits – Parking enforcement hours end at 5 pm (surface lots) or 6 pm (parking structures) and resume at 6 am during the week for the following Medical Campus parking areas. During this time no parking permit is required. Anyone who utilizes this option <u>must exit prior to 6 am</u>.

- M5, Catherine Structure
- M61, Glen Structure
- Lot M27 (on Zina Pitcher Place at Ann St., next to Ann St. structure)
- Lot M28 (on Washington Hts., near Mary Markley residence hall)
- Lot M29 ("The Pit" lot, below the Survival Flight helipad)

WEEKEND PARKING

Orange Permits – All orange lots and those listed under "No Parking Permits" may also be utilized within enforcement hours. *Note: Buses are limited, please check <u>ltp.umich.edu</u> for more information.*

Yellow AVI Permits – Including P3 access, the Yellow AVI permit is also valid at P5 (Cardiovascular) and P4 (Mott/Simpson) Parking Structures from 5:15 pm Friday to 8 am Monday.

Blue AVI Permits – Lot M95 (gravel lot next to Mary Markley residence hall), P1 (Cancer Center) and P4 (Mott/Simpson) structures are enforced 24 hours/7 days. Blue parkers will find available parking spaces throughout the weekend.

SPECIAL PROGRAM FOR ON-CALL OR STAY-OVER

Parking at the P3 (Taubman) or P5 (Cardiovascular Center) Parking Structures is available to staff who are called into work early (emergencies, staff shortages, etc.) or are asked to stay-over from their regular shift. Staff must have a valid Blue or Yellow parking permit to participate. Monday through Friday, supervisors are to call in advance to make entry or exit arrangements for staff by calling (734) 764-8291 from 7:30 am to 5 pm or (734) 763-5555 from 5 pm to 7:30 am.

EAST MEDICAL CAMPUS EMPLOYEE PARKING SHUTTLE

This option is completely free, and no permit is required. This lot can be used to get you to the hospital for any shifts you have throughout the week at main medical campus. Here's an overview:

- Service will begin from the EC1 lot at 3:20 a.m. on Monday mornings. Service ends at 5 a.m. on Saturday morning.
- Shuttles will pick up parkers from bus shelters located in the EC1 parking lot and drop them off at their parked cars on the return trip.

• From 5 a.m. until midnight:

- o From the EC1 lot, employees will be shuttled directly to the Rogel Cancer Center circle drive and the UH South staff entrance. Riders may disembark at either location.
- o To return to parking, riders can pick the shuttle service up at the Rogel Cancer Center circle drive or the UH South staff entrance.
- O Shuttle service will be approximately every 7-10 minutes during peak times and approximately every 15 minutes during off-peak hours.

• From midnight until 5 a.m.:

- From the EC1 lot, employees will be shuttled to the Taubman Entrance. Shuttle service will leave the EC1 lot at midnight, 12:20 a.m., 12:40 a.m., 1 a.m. and continuing in this pattern every 20 minutes until 5 a.m.
 - (Note that Monday morning service from 3:20 a.m. until 5 a.m. will go directly to the Taubman Entrance).
- To return to parking, riders can pick shuttle service up (late night service, operating 10:30 p.m. 5 a.m.) at the Taubman Entrance.
- For individuals needing an ADA-accessible vehicle, this can be scheduled in advance by calling (734) 999-0468.
