Fuel Access Options

U-M Equipment Equipment owned or leased by a U-M department not part of the U-M fleet owned and

managed by LTP Fleet Services unless the fuel device has been disabled.

Container Fuel dispensed into approved containers for use in U-M equipment such as lawn mowers,

generators, tractors, etc.

Other LTP at its discretion, with prior approval from U-M leadership, may allow access to the

service stations for non U-M equipment.

Use and Restrictions

Fuel for U-M authorized vehicles and equipment only.

- Not to be used for vehicles owned and managed by LTP Fleet Services unless the fuel device has been disabled.
- Not to be used by an individual or department to dispense fuel into a personal vehicle or equipment.
- Fuel dispensed into containers will be **certified** portable fuel containers legal for the transportation of fuel.

Compliance

Logistics, Transportation & Parking, University Audits and others may investigate use of fuel access to confirm compliance. If non-compliance (misuse) is found, the administrator will be notified and further access may be suspended or terminated. In addition, if a staff member is found to be using this access for personal use, the matter may be turned over to the Department of Public Safety, University Audits and Human Resources.

Note

A fuel device is not required for the U-M fleet vehicles owned and managed by LTP Fleet Services. The U-M fleet is equipped with a Vehicle Identification Unit (VIU) which will automatically provide access to the U-M LTP service stations for fuel unless this device has been disabled.

Access to the campus fuel system is a two part process. This application will provide access for the vehicle or equipment. In order to obtain fuel, employees will also need access which is requested on the EMPLOYEE FUEL ACCESS APPLICATION.
